

***"For power to come back in India and make it once again attain its once pristine stage, each and every individual has to make some conscious effort to bring tangible transformation in their life in their character and attitude".***









***“ If we are better individuals, we can change society and can see that everything goes well. I look forward to put into practice what I have discovered here today.”***





***“ We have to share the power we have by serving the community through social welfare projects.”***




